POINTE TECHNIQUE

Course Syllabus

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Class will consist of *pointe* barre and center exercises based upon the classical ballet vocabulary and theories of order, tempo, placement and musicality as taught by the instructor.

COURSE OBJECTIVE

The student shall acquire the intellectual, aesthetic and physical benefits of classical ballet *pointe* training.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS

CLASS ATTENDANCE

1. Students are permitted no more than THREE absences. A student with a FOURTH absence will receive a grade of U (unsatisfactory) in the course. There is no distinguishing between an excused absence and un-excused absence. When necessary a student may observe a class, however, two observations will count as an absence.
2. Technique classes will begin five minutes after and end five minutes before the University designated class time to allow students time to dress. Any student entering the studio later than ten minutes after the designated class time will be considered tardy and not allowed to take the class. Tardy students will remain to observe the class.
3. Always inform your instructor if you are injured or ill.

DRESS CODE

Leotard should reflect current level of technique class:

DANC 1660 Ballet I	Block Leotard L551048 Black & Red
DANC 2660 Ballet II	Block Leotard L551048 Black & Blue
DANC 3660 Ballet III	Block Leotard L551048 Black & Lavender
DANC 4660 Ballet IV	Block Leotard L551048 Black & White

1. Pink tights should be purchased with feet in them and should be worn on the inside of the leotard and *pointe* shoes.
2. Hair should be pulled away from the face and secured at the back of the head. Excessive jewelry and watches should not be worn in class.
3. No sweat pants, jazz pants, skirts, shorts, baggy shirts or warmers may be worn.

4. Should an injury arise, **pink leg warmers** may be worn on the legs and **black close fitted knit warmers** on the torso. Excessively bright or colored warmers are not permitted at any time.
5. Failure to comply with dress code regulations will result in the student receiving only half credit for attendance on that date.
