The Franklin College seeks two Administrative Fellows in Diversity Leadership for the 2021-2022 academic year. This is an opportunity for a tenured faculty member with an interest in diversity engagement to partner with the Dean's Office in creating and supporting opportunities for inclusive excellence in the College for faculty, staff, and students.

Each Fellow's portfolio will include:

- Assisting the College's Diversity Leadership team in coordinating the College's ongoing diversity initiatives
- Leading a new initiative relating to enhancing DEI
- Meeting with members of the College administration and Franklin departments to support DEI work
- Facilitating partnerships in DEI projects with other colleges on campus
- Participating in meetings of Franklin administrators and Unit Heads to gain a broader perspective on higher education administration in the College and at UGA

The Fellows will collaborate with Associate Dean Jean Martin-Williams, the Director of the College's Office of Inclusion and Diversity Leadership, and Nakia Wade, Human Resources Senior Manager for the College.

Applications are encouraged from tenured faculty in the Franklin College who have disciplinary and/or experiential background in diversity and inclusion work as evidenced by their research/scholarship, teaching, and/or university and disciplinary outreach. Each Fellow will receive a support account of \$5500 which can be used for a course release or scholarly support.
