



UGA Franklin-LMU Munich Spring 2020 Faculty Research Exchange Call for Applications

Application Deadline: Friday 1 November 2019

The week-long **UGA Franklin-LMU Munich Faculty Research Exchange** is open to tenured and tenure-track faculty from any discipline in the Franklin College. Through this program, faculty at both institutions have the opportunity to collaborate on common research in their field. Faculty are expected to be on the Munich campus for one business week. UGA faculty may opt to visit Munich in the summer, as Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität München's (LMU) summer semester runs from mid-April until the end of July.

Activities

While participating in this exchange, both faculty are expected to:

- Develop a plan for and/or collaborate on common research;
- Offer a public lecture (or equivalent presentation) about their research;
- Develop research associations with the host department/faculty member with a view toward future joint funding application, or other scholarly initiatives involving both institutions.

Expenses Covered for the UGA Faculty Member

The Franklin College will cover international airfare between Atlanta and Munich as well as ground transportation to and from the airport in Atlanta. UGA faculty will book accommodation independently from among a select group of hotels in Munich that LMU can later contact to arrange payment on behalf of the UGA faculty member.

Meal expenses will not be covered.

Expenses Covered for the LMU Faculty Member

LMU will cover international airfare between Munich and Atlanta. The Franklin College will provide overnight accommodation as well as ground transportation between the Atlanta airport and Athens.

Meal expenses will not be covered.

- Statements from the academic department heads at both institutions endorsing the exchange (e-mail will suffice). UGA department heads must explain—if applicable—how the UGA faculty member's classes will be covered during the week abroad.
- Confirmation from the LMU International Office that they will cover airfare for the LMU faculty and lodging for the UGA faculty.
