The decision for the termination of the program is based on low graduation rates in a major that combines the study of Russian and German. This is not a primary major in our program and it does not require any additional resources; however, this in itself does not suffice to justify the continuation of the program. Students currently enrolled in the program will be allowed to graduate through December 2019. Dr. Keith Langston, the department's undergraduate advisor, will counsel those students and oversee their progress toward completion of the degree. Students interested in pursuing the study of German and Russian now and in the future also have the option to double-major in German and Russian or minor in either or both of the fields. Since this program is resource-neutral, there will be no negative impact on faculty and/or staff through its termination.
