Jane Mulkey Green and Rufus King Green Graduate Fellowship Fund

Each department may submit one nomination for this fellowship.

- 1. The Green Fellowship will provide academic-year support to a graduate student in Franklin College. The award is in addition to any graduate assistantship held by the student and cannot be used as a substitute for any portion of an assistantship. Criteria for selection will be based upon the individual's character, academic achievement, and talent primarily in Arts and Humanities in the areas of Classics, Theatre and Film Studies, English, History, or Communications Studies. Preference will be given to, but not limited to, students who are graduates of any programs in Arts and Sciences at Wesleyan College in Macon, Georgia.
- 2. The graduate coordinator should solicit a one-page statement of purpose from the student, which describes educational and career goals of the nominee, and an estimated budget for the intended use of award funds.
- 3. The graduate coordinator should include two letters of recommendation attesting to the applicant's academic qualifications and scholarly accomplishments / potential. Send letters via email directly to pettik@uga.edu
- 4. The graduate coordinator should ask the nominee to complete the scholarship application at: https://franklin.uga.edu/sites/default/files/users/Graduate%20Scholarship%20application%202022.pdf
- 5. If 1-4 above are met, the student is eligible to be considered for a fellowship. A fellowship recipient may reapply in subsequent years as long as he/she meets the criteria.
- 6. The amount of each award will depend on the size and qualifications of the applicant pool. Previous awards have ranged from \$2,000-\$5,000.
